Health Tips

What is malaria

Malaria is a serious and sometimes fatal disease caused by a parasite that commonly infects a certain type of mosquito which feeds on humans. People who get malaria are typically very sick with high fevers, shaking chills, and flu-like illness.

Symptoms of malaria?

The symptoms of malaria typically develop within 10 days to 4 weeks following the infection. In some cases, symptoms may not develop for several months. Some malarial parasites can enter the body but will be dormant for long periods of time.

A malaria infection is generally characterized by the following signs and symptoms:

- Fever
- Chills
- Headache
- Nausea and vomiting
- Muscle pain and fatigue

Other signs and symptoms may include:

- Sweating
- Chest or abdominal pain
- Cough

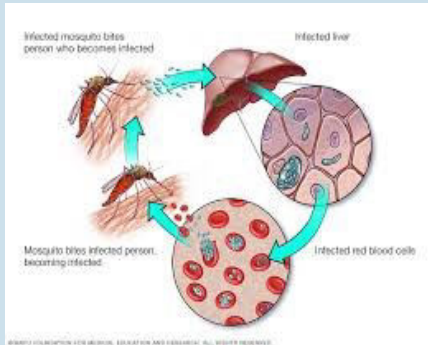
Causes

Malaria is caused by a type of microscopic parasite. The parasite is transmitted to humans most commonly through mosquito bites.

Prevention

If you live or traveling to an area where malaria is common, take steps to avoid mosquito bites. Mosquitoes are most active between dusk and dawn. To protect yourself from mosquito bites, you should:

- Cover your skin. Wear pants and long-sleeved shirts.
- Apply insect repellent to skin and clothing. Sprays containing DEET can be used on skin and sprays containing permethrin are safe to apply to clothing.
- Sleep under a net. Bed nets, particularly those treated with insecticide; help prevent mosquito bites while you are sleeping.
