3.0 ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- (i) Evidence of registration with the Corporate Affairs Commission, (CAC) including Form CAC2 and CAC7:
- (ii) Evidence of Income's Tax Clearance Certificate for the past three (3) years (2018, 2019, 2020) valid till 31st December 2021
- (iii) Evidence of Current Pension Compliance Certificate valid till 31st December, 2021.

- (iv) Evidence of current Industrial Training Fund (ITF) Compliance Certificate valid till 31st December, 2021.
- (v) Evidence of current Nigeria Social Insurance Trust Fund (NSITF) Compliance Certificate valid till 31st December, 2021.
- (vi) Evidence of Registration on the National Database of Federal Contractors, Consultants and Service providers by submission of Interim Registration Report, (IRR) expiring on 31/12/2021 or valid Certificate issued by BPP;
- (vii) A Sworn Affidavit disclosing whether or not any officer of the relevant committees of the Federal Radio Corporation of Nigeria or the Bureau of Public Procurement is a former or present Director, shareholder or has any pecuniary interest in the bidder, that the company is not bankrupt, in receivership or under liquidation or involved in any litigation which can potentially affect the company's ability to effectively discharge its responsibility if engaged and to confirm that all information presented in its bid are true and correct in all particulars;
- (viii) Company's Audited Accounts for the last three (3) years – 2018, 2019 and 2020
- (ix) Evidence of financial capability to execute the project by submission of Reference Letter from a reputable commercial bank in Nigeria, indicating willingness to provide credit facility for the execution of the project when needed;
Evidence of OEM accreditation/authorization letter (where applicable);
- (x) Verifiable documentary evidence of at least three (3) similar jobs executed in the last five (5) years including Letters of awards and Job Completion Certificates;
- (xi) All documents for submission must be transmitted with a covering/forwarding letter under the company/firm's Letter Head Paper bearing amongst others, the Registration Number (RC), as issued by the Corporate Affairs Commission (CAC), Contact Address, etc
- (xii) Telephone Number (preferably GSM No.), and e-mail address. The Letterhead Paper must bear the Names and Nationalities of the Directors of the Company at the bottom of the page, duly signed by the authorised officer of the firm.

4.0 COLLECTION OF BID DOCUMENTS.

Interested companies are to collect bid documents from office of the Secretary, Parastatal Tenders' Board (Room 19, 2nd Floor, Radio House) upon payment of non-refundable fee of N10,000.00 = (Ten Thousand Naira) only, per lot, payable to the Federal Radio Corporation of Nigeria (Headquarters) through REMITA platform at any commercial bank. Evidence of such payment is to be presented at the point of collection of the bid documents, between 9.00am and 4.00 pm Mondays to Fridays.

5.0 SUBMISSION OF BID DOCUMENTS.

Bidders are to submit both technical and financial bids in separate, sealed envelopes, clearly marked "Technical" and "Financial". Each envelope, whether technical or financial, must state the lot number

on the top-right corner. The name and address of the bidder, including valid contact telephone numbers must be clearly stated on the back of each envelope. Failure to abide by these regulations may lead to disqualification.

6.0 OPENING OF BIDS

Only technical bids will be opened immediately after the deadline for submission at **12:00 noon on 26th April, 2021 at Radio House, Garki-Abuja.**
